Les Bolstad Golf Course Redevelopment Community Advisory Committee (CAC)

The Falcon Heights Community Advisory Committee (CAC), a nine-member voting committee appointed by the City Council, held its first meeting on Wednesday, May 20, 2026, marking the beginning of a community-focused effort to help guide the future redevelopment of the Les Bolstad Golf Course.

The CAC will meet monthly on the third Wednesday of each month at 6:30 p.m., with most meetings at City Hall unless otherwise noted. Meetings are open to the public for observation.

The next meeting will be off-site on Wednesday, June 17th, at 6 p.m. at the Highland Bridge (Ford Plant) development in St. Paul for a walking tour of the site, with a meeting immediately following at the Lunds & Byerlys meeting room. 2026 Neal Kwong Youth Citizenship Award Recipient – Katherine Fisher

Neal Kwong was a Falcon Heights resident who tragically passed away at the age of fifteen. He was an outstanding member of our community!

In his memory, the City established the Neal Kwong Award to recognize young people, ages 12 to 19, who display leadership and volunteerism in Falcon Heights.

This year's Neal Kwong Citizenship Award recipient is Katherine Fisher, who was presented with the award during the May 27th City Council meeting.

Katherine is a dedicated student, a member of National Honor Society, and has achieved high honor roll every semester at DeLaSalle High School. Katherine volunteers regularly at Norway House, at St. John Paul II Catholic School, and by tutoring students in mathematics. Katherine has also served on her school's ethics board and economics competition team, and participated in track and field and cross country.

Along with her volunteerism and overall helpfulness, Katherine Fisher is a deserving recipient of this year's Neal Kwong Youth Citizen Award.

Road Construction Updates

Fairview Avenue Resurfacing

Ramsey County, in collaboration with the city of Roseville, is working to resurface Fairview Avenue between County Road B2 and Larpenteur Avenue.

This project will include a mill and overlay of the roadway, installation of new signals at County Road B and Gluek Lane and trail improvements.

This stretch of Fairview Avenue will be closed beginning on Monday, June 1.

Snelling Ave./Highway 51 Closure

Repairs and resurfacing on nearly 3.5 miles of Highway 51/Snelling Avenue in Arden Hills and Roseville continue.

Road closures

8 p.m. Fri, May 29 through 5 a.m. Mon, June 1

- Northbound Snelling Ave. is closed between Hwy 36 in Roseville and I-694 in Arden Hills

8 p.m. Fri, June 12 through 5 a.m. Mon, June 15

- Southbound Snelling Ave. is closed between I-694 in Arden Hills and Hwy 36 in Roseville

Ramp closures

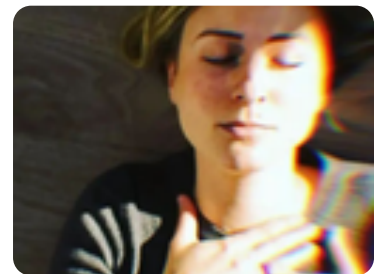
